Jewel Basin Hawk Watch is a scientific data collection project with the purpose of monitoring the autumn raptor migration. The watch is a cooperative effort between the Flathead Audubon Society and the US Forest Service, Region 1. The Basin is located in the Swan Mountain Range east of Kalispell. The hike takes approximately two hours with an elevation gain of approximately 2300 feet.
