

2023 BIRDATHON REPORT



For the first time, we conducted our annual Birdathon during our Wings Across the Big Sky Festival in June. Overall, 153 species were recorded by our festival participants during a 24-hour period, which included Saturday morning field trips. The rules were still followed – same 24-hour period for everyone and only in Montana. In the past, our staff and board would spread out across the state to see as many bird species as possible. This year, we tried something different by confining ourselves to the Great Falls region but hoping, by having more

people participate, we would see just as many birds. In the end, the experiment worked as we did encounter a good representation of bird life in Montana!

Friday night at the festival, we sounded the horn as Birdathon kicked off with 131 festival goers (that's 262 sets of eyes and ears!) who were tasked with finding as many bird species as they could in a 24-hour period.

Some of the highlights for this year:

- 1 Pileated Woodpecker (Peeble's Crossing);
- 1 Sprague's Pipit at Benton Lake;
- 1 Cordilleran Flycatcher was seen building a nest;
- 5 species of grebes;
- 6 species of swallows;
- 47 White-throated Swifts at Sluice Boxes (calling and chattering); American Dippers were seen on the Bluebird trip in Dry Wolf Creek; Buffleheads were observed in standing water along Morony Dam Rd; Veeries were abundant along the Highwood Creek Road; Short-eared, Burrowing and Great-Horned Owls (strange that no owls were actually seen at night)
