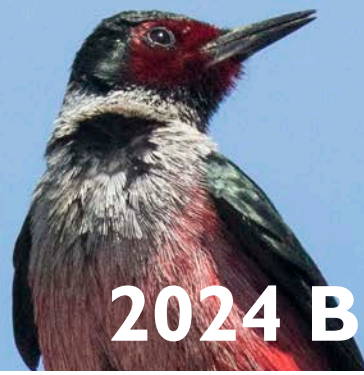


Lewis's Woodpecker



2024 Birdathon Report

We count birds because birds count on us!

The 2024 Montana Audubon Birdathon took place over a 24 hour period starting at 6 pm on June 26, and ending at 6 pm on June 27. Five staff members covered a lot of ground, ranging from Medicine Lake National Wildlife Refuge in the far north-east corner of the state, to Helena and the Elkhorn Mountains, to Council Groves State Park in the Missoula Valley, and many favorite birding locations in between.

Though thunderstorms in some parts of the state slowed us down a bit, we still managed to detect a grand total of **168 species**, including 25 Species of Concern! (See following page for full list).



Short-eared Owl

Some 2024 highlights:

- Nelson's Sparrow- which has a very limited range in Montana- detected north of Medicine Lake
- Short-eared Owl and Ferruginous Hawk on the prairie outside of Lavina, and Burrowing Owl in a prairie dog town nearby
- Canada Jay in the Elkhorns
- A pair of Yellow-breasted Chats near the National Bison Range
- Purple Martin colony in the town siren in Medicine Lake
- Red-necked Grebe on Pablo Reservoir
- Willow Flycatcher along Prickly Pear Creek
- Clay-colored Sparrow and Wood Duck at the Lewis & Clark Fairgrounds in Helena
- Two Common Loons on Kicking Horse Reservoir
- SO many waterbirds & waterfowl at Medicine Lake National Wildlife Refuge, including 3 tern species, 3 grebe species, and breeding American White Pelicans, California and Ring-billed Gulls
